Progressive jazz rock

Robin & The Woods is an instrumental quintet offering an organic music mixing colours and influences, inspired by 70's progressive rock (King Crimson, Mike Oldfield, Pink Floyd) and modern jazz (EST, Pat Metheny, John Hollenbeck, Donny McCaslin).

The music of Robin & The Woods evolves between a dense writing and a refined style, leaving a large part to improvisation. A musical signature that will allow the group to win the FIP Prize and the Grand Prize of the Tremplin Action Jazz, in 2018.

For their first album, Moonfall, Robin & The Woods distills a roaming instrumental music with lyrical flights, telluric rhythms and libertarian breaths.
